

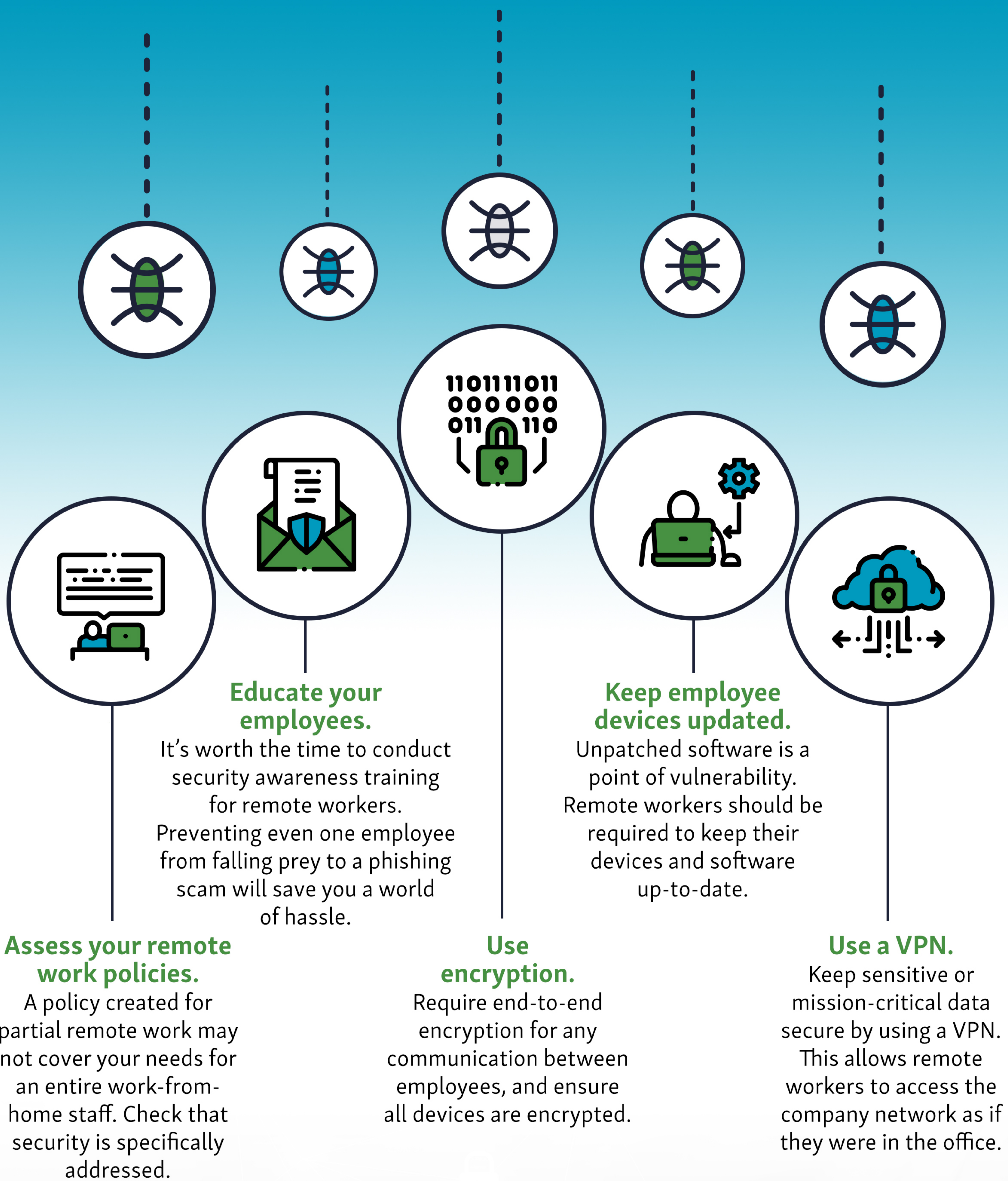


# 5 Best Practices FOR REMOTE WORK SECURITY
